## **Romans 10:1 – 11:10**

**There are two kinds of righteousness.**

### **1. Legal Righteousness (salvation)**

This righteousness comes from trusting God to declare us legally righteous in the courtroom of heaven based on what Jesus did on the cross.

Rom. 1:16-17    3:21-24    4:1-6    5:1    5:8-9

### **2. Practical Righteousness (a godly lifestyle)**

This righteousness is defined as daily acts of obedience to God and love for others.

<sup>8</sup>For you were once darkness, but now *you are* light in the Lord. Walk as children of light <sup>9</sup>  
(for the fruit of the Spirit *is* in all goodness, righteousness, and truth)    Ephesians 5:8-9

<sup>14</sup>Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of  
righteousness,    Ephesians 6:14

<sup>29</sup>If you know that He is righteous, you know that everyone who practices righteousness is born  
of Him.    I John 2:29

<sup>7</sup>Little children, let no one deceive you. He who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He  
is righteous.    I John 3:7

<sup>10</sup>In this the children of God and the children of the devil are manifest: Whoever does not practice  
righteousness is not of God, nor *is* he who does not love his brother.    I John 3:10

<sup>9</sup>The LORD your God will make you abound in all the work of your hand, in the <sup>[a]</sup>fruit of your body, in the increase of your livestock, and in the produce of your land for good. For the LORD will again rejoice over you for good as He rejoiced over your fathers, <sup>10</sup>if you obey the voice of the LORD your God, to keep His commandments and His statutes which are written in this Book of the Law, *and* if you turn to the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul

<sup>11</sup>“For this commandment which I command you today *is* not *too* mysterious for you, nor *is* it far off. <sup>12</sup>It *is* not in heaven, that you should say, ‘Who will ascend into heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?’ <sup>13</sup>Nor *is* it beyond the sea, that you should say, ‘Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?’ <sup>14</sup>But the word *is* very near you, in your mouth and in your heart, that you may do it. Deuteronomy 30:9-14
